Integrating student driven learning in a Learning Languages classroom

Workshop description

This workshop will focus on integrating student driven learning into a Learning Languages classroom with a view to raising NCEA achievement. Underpinning this is the integration of e-learning and assessment in a learning languages classroom and differentiation in a combined level learning languages classroom.

Learning outcomes

Participants will take part in a differentiated workshop with the focus on 4 different learning stations covering the following:

- Successful portfolio tasks for the internal interaction and writing portfolios
- E-learning and the use of digital tools
- Effective planning in combined level classes
- Raising NCEA achievement at Levels 1-2 through student focused learning in years 9-10
